Precision lacquering is applied to protect the exclusive natural wood finishes or the multiple layers of high quality colour finishes.



Hand polishing ensures a perfect finish of each drum shell and the outstanding looks that are a hallmark of Sonor instruments.

Each shell is created to OSM Optimum Shell Measurements for optimized contact of the drum head, giving excellent tone and ease of tuning.

Sonor drum shells feature a 45° bearing edge, designed and introduced by us already in 1975, for maximum resonance and sustain.



Every SQ<sup>2</sup> snare drum is carefully assembled by hand and precision tuned before shipping.
